Our thoughts are very much with you all at this time and we hope and trust that you will soon be very much better and so able to enjoy a measure of good health again.

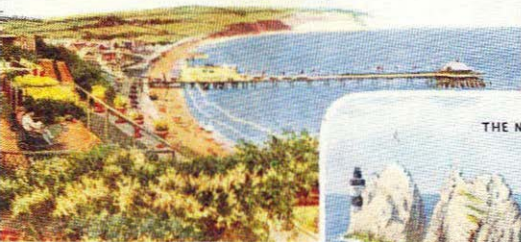

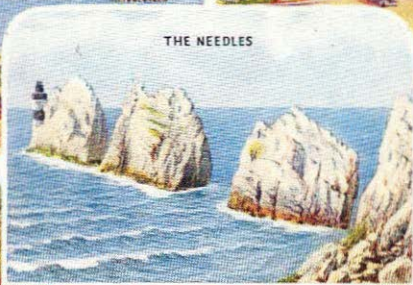

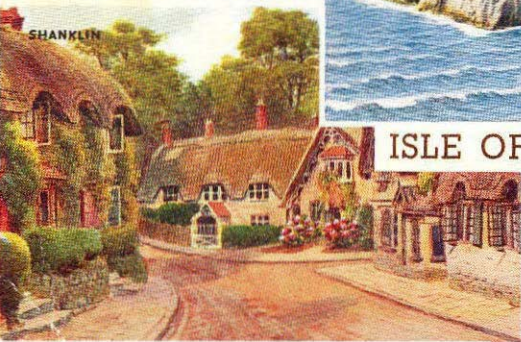
