"Starting in the North-east corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Twp. 76, Rge. 21, West of 4th, thence South-east to cabin on Lake in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Twp. 76, Rge. 20, West of 4th, continuing South-east to the South-east corner of Section 13, Twp. 76, Rge. 20, thence South-east to East 3 miles to corner of Section 4, Twp. 76, Rge. 19, thence directly North on Section line to the North-east corner of Section 25, Twp. 76, Rge. 19, thence North-east to cabin on the West shore of Athabasca River in approx. the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Twp. 76, Rge. 18, West of 4th, thence directly to the North-east corner of Section 36, Twp. 76, Rge. 19, the South-west West 2 miles, South 1 mile and straight West 6 miles thence North-west corner of Section 35, Twp. 76, Rge. 20, West of 4th, thence the South-west about 1 mile to the East shore of a lake in approximate of 4th. Another corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Twp. 76, Rge. 20, West of Section 25, arm starts at the center of the East boundary of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Athabasca River Twp. 76, Rge. 19, West of 4th, thence South-east to corner 30, Twp. 76, Rge. 18, West of 4th, thence South-east to the North-west corner of Section 21, same Twp. & Rge., thence directly East 3 miles to the North-east corner of Section 23, same Twp. & Rge., thence South 2 miles to the South-east corner of Section 14, Twp. 76, Rge. 18, thence North-west to the North-west corner of Section 21, Twp. 76, Rge. 18, West of 4th. Charles Lindholm to have priority where his line crosses that of B. Gambler in Twp. 76, Rge. 20, West of 4th Meridian."-----
