ALBERTA ENVIRONMENT THE WATER RESOURCES ACT RED DEER RIVER DIVERSION (BUFFALO LAKE STABILIZATION)

Her Majesty the Queen in right of Alberta, as represented by the Minister of Environment (Alberta Environment), has filed an application and plans under the provisions of the Water Resources Act to construct the necessary works to divert 18,300 acre-feet of water annually from the Red Deer River in the NE 34-38-23-4 for the purpose of stabilizing Buffalo Lake within its historic lake levels.

The works consist of an intake and pump-house on the north bank of the Red Deer River and a combination of approximately 8 kilometres of pipeline and canal from the Red Deer River to Ailix Lake in the NE 24-39-23-4. Also, improvements to the existing licensed control structure on Ailix Lake and downstream channel to Paribey Creek will be undertaken. Water for Buffalo Lake will be conveyed via the Paribey Creek Channel Improvement Project, Phases I through IV.
